She suggested that we consider where God has been present in our lives, and to reflect upon our experiences in terms of the mysteries of the rosary: joyful, sorrowful, glorious, and luminous. Her wit, wisdom, and experience make her a wonderful role model as a woman who is indeed "aging in grace."

Whenever I attend a workshop at The Women's Table, I always feel as if I'm coming home, due in large part to the warm, welcoming presence of Mary Rita Weschler, CSJA. As Director of The Women's Table, she provides amazing opportunities for women.

One of the greatest joys of *Crossroads and Thresholds* was meeting other women who share a desire to grow in faith and self-awareness, and who see this time in our lives as one of "infinite possibilities", as one participant so wisely stated.
